

# Voce Chamber Singers Covid Policy

Updated March 15, 2022

Voce Chamber Singers is committed to the safety of all who perform and attend our performances. We invite you to join in the effort to slow the spread of COVID-19. Voce joins performing arts venues across the greater Northern Virginia and Washington, D.C. area in providing the highest level of public safety for our audiences, artists, staff, and volunteers, by requesting that our audiences respect the following guidelines:

- Based on updated guidance released by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), the Fairfax County Health Department recommends the following: In areas at a low community level, you can make the choice whether to wear a mask. In choosing whether to mask, in addition to your personal preference, you may consider your own risk of developing severe illness, the risk of others around you, and whether you are in contact with young children who are not yet eligible to get vaccinated. You may be at higher risk if you are an older adult, are pregnant/were recently pregnant, or [have certain medical conditions](#).
- Fully vaccinated status is highly recommended for audience members but not required in order to attend a performance.
- We recommend maintaining 6 ft distancing between households.

How we are maintaining safe practices:

- We comply with all current CDC requirements and recommendations
- All members of Voce are fully vaccinated
- Anyone experiencing Covid-like symptoms are asked not to attend rehearsals and are encouraged to get tested
